In 1975, Bob was busy with school duties. Ann Jesse Driever, Jeff Waldron, Susan Mattivi-Gierga and Kathie William Chase did not participate energetically with fund raising. However, Bob, Jeff, Ann, Susan and Kathie do not have the RIGHT to use Class of 1975 funds or our Facebook page. I am stunned Susan and others refuse to share classmate contact information.
